India's recovery rate at 60%, over 3.9 lakh people recover from COVID-19

India has been grappling with the COVID-19 pandemic for over five months now. After around two months of lockdown, the country opened up in a phased manner from June 8 and people are getting used to the new normal. Some states are continuing to see a rise in coronavirus patients and continue to enforce restrictions.

According to the Union Health Ministry, the total number of cases in India as of 10 am on July 4 stands at 6,48,315 with 22,771 new cases in the past 24 hours. Of these, 2,35,433 patients are still under treatment. A total of 3,94,227 patients have recovered, which makes India's recovery rate 60.8% as of Saturday.

The COVID-19 positivity rate in Delhi has declined to 10.58 per cent after rising to nearly 37 per cent, and the average number of cases has also dropped by almost 1,000 over the previous week, indicating a welcome trend, though experts have cautioned the people against lowering their guard.

The national capital's recovery rate too has risen significantly crossing 70 per cent, Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia said.

Amazon eliminates single-use plastic in packaging in India

Amazon said it has eliminated all single-use plastic in its packaging across its fulfillment centers in India, delivering on a pledge it made last year to achieve this goal by June.

The American e-commerce group said it had replaced packaging materials such as bubble wrap with paper cushions and was also using “100% plastic-free biodegradable” paper tapes. All of Amazon's 50-plus fulfillment centers in India, one of its key overseas markets, are complying with the new guidelines, the company said.

BillerudKorsnäs launches three-ply kraftliner

BillerudKorsnäs has launched Pure Performance, a white top kraftliner that it says combines “high strength, excellent printability, and purity in one material”.

Pure Performance is one of the first products to utilise BillerudKorsnäs' KM7 board machine.

The company claims that its new kraftliner can provide material reduction and “extraordinary strength”, thanks to its three-ply construction. The top ply contains short white fibres optimized for printability, the bottom ply has unbleached long fibres for strength, and the middle ply is used to create bulk with the aim of maximizing stiffness and minimizing warpage.

International Paper becomes minority shareholder of IP APPM

NYSE-listed International Paper Co., who sold off its controlling interest in India based writing and printing paper business International Paper APPM Limited (IP APPM) to West Coast Paper Mills Limited (WCPL) last year, became a minority shareholder of IP APPM on Friday.

The US-based major diluted 17.2 % of its stake in IP APPM (now renamed, Andhra Paper Limited) through an offer-for-sale (OFS) to institutional, high net worth individuals and retail investors over the last two days. Pre-OFS, International Paper held 20 % stake in the company. Post OFS, they are left with a residual stake of 2.8% only. As per Sebi guidelines, IP will have to wait for 12 weeks before selling of their remaining stake.

U.S. Paper and Wood Products industry sets record-high levels of Tissue production during COVID-19 pandemic

American Forest & Paper Association (AF&PA) President and CEO Heidi Brock commented, regarding the U.S. paper and wood products industry's record-high levels of tissue production in February and March in response to unprecedented demand from COVID-19: “The men and women who work in the paper and wood products industry continue to do their part to respond to demand for products like bathroom tissue and paper towels during the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. United States tissue mills manufactured nearly 700,000 tons of tissue in March, more than any other month since 2007, when AF&PA began collecting related monthly historical data. This rate works out to more than 4 pounds of tissue for each U.S. resident. U.S tissue manufacturers also reached a milestone for daily production at a time of unprecedented need. In February and March, AF&PA members safely and reliably delivered more than 22,000 tons of tissue per day – an all-time high for the industry. As daily production reached new thresholds, AF&PA member companies stayed the course, delivering sustainable tissue products to meet everyday, essential needs. I am heartened by the industry's commitment to safety, and its ability to move products to the global market – just as we do 52 weeks each year”.

The long-pending demand of the paper industry to hike the import duty from 10 percent to 20-25 percent may see the light soon. The recent brutal confrontation between Indian and Chinese soldiers on the LAC is simmering the anti-Chinese sentiments among the countrymen. The current situation may flow the wind in favour of Paper mills owners. According to Media reports, Government may soon impose an additional 10 to 15 percent import duty on coated paper and paperboard in order to combat Chinese import.
