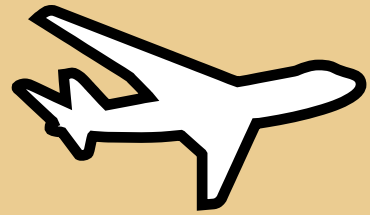

AIRPORT TRANSFERS



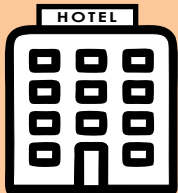
Due to the traffic in Delhi, **the fastest** way to get from the airport to your hotel or exhibition venue is by public transport.

- Information about the nearest metro stations available from Delhi International airport (specifying the Delhi metro routes - map) International Airport (T3) to New Delhi (Orange Line), New Delhi to Rajiv Chowk (Yellow Line) and Rajiv Chowk to Pragati Maidan (Blue Line). - Information about Uber or Ola cabs, airport taxis (public transport) available from airport to hotels booked or exhibition venue. Exhibitors can take UBER / OLA from their respective pick up zones available at the airport. Airport taxis can be easily book from the authorized taxi counter available at the airport
- The average price for a taxi journey to and from the airports is around INR 400 – INR 500.

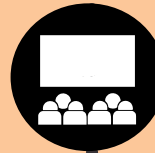


MUSEUMS

- Madame Tussaud's Wax Museum (Metro Station: Rajiv Chowk)
 - National Museum (Metro Station: Janpath)
 - Rashtrapati Bhawan Museum
 - National Handicrafts and Handlooms Museum (Metro Station: Pragati Maidan)
 - National Gallery of Modern Art (Metro Station: Central Secretariat)
 - India Gate (Metro Station: Khan Market)
 - Red Fort (Metro Station: Lal Quila) – Enjoy Sound & Light Shows in the Evening from 6 pm onwards.
- Other popular sites include: Qutub Minar, Humayun's Tomb, Lotus Temple, Akshardham Temple, Purana Quila and many more.

Delhi's has an extreme climate. It is very hot in summer (April - July) and cold in winter (December - January). The average temperature can vary from 25oC to 45oC during the summer and 22oC to 5oC during the winter. Please check the weather forecast before your trip.
